

ACE Life awards scholarships to over 300 students

ACE Life Insurance Co. Ltd. awarded 181 scholarships to needy and bright students in the south of Vietnam yesterday at HCMC Youth Cultural House.

Another 51 scholarships for students in Danang and 81 for students in Hanoi will be presented by the company tomorrow and this Friday, respectively. The scholarships are worth a total of VND932 million.

This is part of the annual "Crossing Waves" scholarship program of the company, which aims to contribute to Vietnam's education cause, particularly helping needy but brilliant students who will become talents in the future. This year, the eligible students achieved good academic results in the university entrance examination but suffer from financial hardship.

In addition to providing this support to first-year students, the company has decided to allocate ten scholarships worth VND2 million to deserving second-year students

who received the scholarship in their first year at the universities and who have continued to achieve good results.

ACE Life Account representatives launched the scholarship program in 2005. They not only contribute their own money to the program but

also set up a committee to screen application forms from students every year upon completion of the university intake.

To date, as many as 781 scholarships worth nearly VND2.2 billion have been given out to students under this program.
